1. Purpose

To ensure that Al Rabeeh Academy maintains effective first aid facilities, trained personnel, and procedures, including the operation of an **Automated External Defibrillator (AED)**, in full compliance with **DoH**, **ADEK**, and **OSHAD** health and safety standards.

2. Scope

Applies to all students, staff, contractors, and visitors on Academy premises and during off-site activities (e.g., trips, sports, events).

3. Rationale

Timely and competent first aid saves lives and limits injury severity. This policy ensures immediate, structured response to incidents—including cardiac emergencies—by providing trained personnel, stocked equipment, and an operational AED unit on site.

4. Regulatory Framework

5. Aims and Objectives

- Provide prompt and effective first aid response and cardiac emergency readiness.
- Ensure qualified first aiders and DoH-licensed nurses are available at all times during school hours and school events.
- Maintain first aid and AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) equipment in full operational condition.
- Promote first aid awareness and training among staff.

6. Responsibilities

6.1 Principal

- o Ensures adequate first aid and AED resources and personnel
- Supports regular drills and emergency preparedness.

6.2 Head of Operations / Health and Safety Lead

- Oversees compliance with DoH and ADOSH standards.
- o Coordinates AED maintenance and staff training.
- Leads annual review and audit of the policy.

6.3 School Nurses / Medical Team

- Must be DoH-licensed and AED-certified.
- Provide first aid, operate the AED if required, and maintain logs and expiry checks.
- o Train staff in basic life support (BLS), **EpiPen** use and AED awareness.

6.4 Designated First Aiders

- Deliver immediate first aid and use the AED in cardiac emergencies until medical help arrives.
- Record all incidents in the official First Aid Logbook.

6.5 All Staff

- Must be familiar with the location of first aid boxes, the AED unit, and emergency procedures.
- Report injuries or illness promptly.

7 First Aid and AED Facilities

7.1 School Clinic

Complies with DoH licensing requirements, equipped with:

- Examination bed, BP apparatus, suction unit, oxygen cylinder, thermometer, and AED unit.
- DoH-approved emergency medicines and consumables.

o Refrigerator for medicines requiring temperature control.

7.2 First Aid Boxes and Travel Kits

- o 30 fixed boxes are distributed throughout the premises (see Appendix I).
- Portable first aid kits are issued for off-site activities.
- o Inspected monthly by the clinic team; deficiencies rectified immediately.

Minimum Contents (as per DoH standards):

Bandages (all types), gauze, plasters, cold packs, micropore tape, gloves, tweezers, scissors, antiseptic cream (Fucidin), anti-itch gel (Fenistil), anti-inflammatory gel (Reparil), tourniquet, biohazard bags, alcohol swabs, tongue depressor, and emergency quide.

7.3 Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

- One AED unit is installed in a centrally accessible and visible area near the main clinic.
- The AED is inspected weekly for readiness (status indicator, pads expiry, battery life).
- Only trained staff and nurses may operate the device.
- AED use is recorded in the Emergency Incident Log and reviewed by the Head of Operations and H&S Officer.
- Regular BLS/AED training is conducted in accordance with DoH Emergency Response and Cardiac Arrest Readiness Guidelines (2024).

8 First Aid Procedure

- Assess the Scene Ensure safety and call for assistance.
- Provide Immediate Care Administer first aid using the nearest kit or summon a nurse.
- Activate Emergency Response If unresponsive or no breathing, begin CPR and use an AED immediately.
- Call 998 (Ambulance) Notify SLT and security to assist with access and crowd control.
- Transfer and Documentation Record the incident and inform parents or guardians.

9 Medication Management

- Only **DoH-approved medications** are administered by licensed nurses.
- Parental consent is required for all medications.
- Medications must be stored in locked cabinets within the clinic.
- Teachers must not administer any medication unless specifically authorized by the nurse.

10 Records and Communication

All first aid and AED incidents must be logged in the Medical Incident Register, including:

- Date, time, and location
- Nature of injury or incident
- Action taken / treatment given
- Whether an AED was used
- Name and signature of responding staff
- Parent notification status

Parents are always informed for:

- Head injuries
- Any AED use in a serious incident
- Illness requiring external medical attention

11 Training and Competency

- All nurses and first aiders must hold current DoH-approved BLS and AED certification.
- At least two trained AED operators per shift must be on-site.
- Refresher training is required every two years.
- Annual staff orientation includes first aid and AED awareness.

12 Monitoring and Review

- Monthly internal audits of first aid and AED equipment are conducted by the Clinic Lead and HSE Officer.
- The policy is reviewed annually or after any major incident.
- Results of drills and inspections are reported to the Executive Principal.
