I am delighted to share how exceptionally well-behaved and mature our students were during our recent **Najah University Expo trip at the ADNEC Centre**. Their conduct throughout the visit was exemplary, they represented the school with respect, curiosity, and enthusiasm.

This was our **second careers and university guidance trip of the year**, and it was wonderful to see how confidently students approached representatives from a wide range of universities. Many took the opportunity to ask thoughtful questions about **entry requirements, course options, and future career pathways**.

On a separate note, I would like to remind you that **Sixth Form mock examinations will begin on Tuesday, 5th November**.

In preparation, students should now be dedicating approximately five hours of revision per week per subject outside of school hours – for example, around one hour per day per subject. Establishing this consistent study routine will ensure they feel confident and well-prepared for their upcoming assessments.
